

Springhill Report for PC Meeting 25th February 2025

Yet again the weather has had a dramatic effect on the roads around Springhill with the temporary repairs to the major potholes failing, resulting in the residents requiring large 4x4's to manoeuvre the ever-deepening abysses.

We are looking to get a major part of the road completely resurfaced by a professional contractor, which we believe is the only practical solution. This, however, will take up the majority of the funds we currently have available.

The committee are looking to arrange several fund-raising events in the village hall so as to put some much needed cash in the pot, but we unfortunately don't have the funds available to pay for the hire of the hall. To this end, we have again asked for a grant from the PC to cover the rental of the village hall for 4 planned events.

The Springhill AGM will be held at 20:00hrs on 24 April 2025. The Swan has kindly allowed us to use their venue at no cost to us.

We are still in consultation with our local MP, who is liaising with the prisons minister on our behalf with reference to the green areas on the estate, the state of the lighting and the ongoing issue with the spring running from prison land which is causing major issues with the roads.

We are planning a community day on Good Friday, when we will be looking to again fill some pot holes, do some litter picking, trim hedges and complete some weeding, all with the intention of tidying up the estate. All volunteers welcome.
